O County Finalists in Singles, Pairs, Triples or Fours in past 3 years. Players selected for Middleton Cup, Eastern Counties League or to represent Essex at national finals. Benevolent, Secretaries' and Unbadged Singles finalist in past 3 years. Borough Singles finalist in past 3 years. Club Championship winner in past 3 years.

2 Wally Ball or Inter-Group KO player during last season. Club 2-wood or Open Singles winner in past 3 years.

4 Borough Pairs, Triples, or Fours Finalist in past 3 years. Club Handicap winner or Championship or 2 Woods finalist in past 3 years. Played more than 3 games for the A Team last season. Played in Ashford Cup during last season.

6 Any player who played 6 or more games for the B Team last season. Blythe Cup Winner in past 3 years.

8 Any player who has played one season or more and has yet to reach a club singles final.

10 Any new bowler with less than one season's bowling experience.

When an established bowler joins the Club and before he has played a full season the Competitions' Secretary shall assess his experience and allocate a handicap accordingly.

NB. The Bowling Committee can make a ONE shot adjustment in circumstances where the grading is considered to be either too generous or too severe.
